

## **Study #6 Bible Reading: Genesis 12:10-20**

12:10 Then there was a famine in the land, and the famine was so severe that Abram went down to Egypt to stay there a while. 11 When he was almost in Egypt, Abram hold his wife Sarai, "I know you're a beautiful woman. 12 When the Egyptians see you, they'll say, 'This is his wife,' and they'll kill me but let you live. 13 Please say you're my sister, so that I'll get along well because of you and stay alive thanks to you."

14 When Abram came to Egypt, the Egyptians saw the woman was very beautiful. 15 When Pharaoh's officers saw her, they praised her to Pharaoh, and the woman was taken to Pharaoh's palace. 16 For her sake he treated Abram well, and Abram got flocks and herds, male donkeys, men and women slaves, female donkeys, and camels.

17 But the LORD inflicted great diseases on Pharaoh and his household on account of Sarai, Abram's wife. 18 Then Pharaoh summoned Abram. "What did you do to me?" he asked. "Why didn't you tell me she's your wife? 19 Why did you say, 'She's my sister,' and let me take her to be my wife? Well, there's your wife; take her and get out."

20 Then Pharaoh gave his men orders about him, and they escorted him, his wife, and everything he had out of the country.
